

Urban Arts Leadership Program Fellowship Partner Eligibility

The Urban Arts Leadership Program is a program of the Greater Baltimore Cultural Alliance

To be eligible for the Urban Arts Leadership Program (UALP) organizations* must meet the following requirements.

- Have demonstrated fiscal responsibility for at least three (3) years
- Must have a Board of Directors
- Must have the staff capacity and ability to manage and mentor UALP Fellow
- Must have a physical home or home base of operation
- Must provide matching funds to engage UALP fellow
- Must be willing to engage the UALP fellow for a minimum of 20 hours a week
- Must be able to have a Project Director. All Project Directors must be full-time employees of your organization and are required to report on the progress of UALP fellows
- Must have a representative that is willing to meet monthly with UALP staff to ensure continuity and productivity during the fellowship
- Must be based in Baltimore or in one of the five surrounding counties
- Must commit for full year of engagement

*Preference will be given to 501(c)(3) organizations in good standing.
