Christopher has also served as President Elect, President and Past President for the Massachusetts Art Education Association and is currently the VP of Communications for the Maryland Art Education Association. Christopher has also designed and built the websites for both Massachusetts and Maryland Associations. He was recognized in 2012 as Massachusetts Museum Art Educator of the Year and in 2013 as Massachusetts Art Educator of the year.
