Award-winning playwright, Jen Silverman's absurdist dark comedy is simultaneously hilarious, inspired and boldly unapologetic. Are you ready for the revolution?

"For the past three years I've been very tired of the ways in which women are stereotyped, dismissed, underestimated, patronized to, passed over, and made invisible," said Director Natka Bianchini who previously directed Iron Crow Theatre's critically-acclaimed and award-winning productions of *Cloud 9* and *The Mystery of Love & Sex.* Jen Silverman's *Collective Rage: A Play in 5 Betties* grabbed me by the throat from its very first moments. It demands that we pay attention to these five women named Betty and that we look beyond the boxes that society has put them — to really *see* them. It's also a raucous, righteous, hilarious celebration of women of all kinds featuring a cast of renegades that spans the spectrum of race, gender presentation, and queerness. In a world that prefers women to play supporting roles, these five Betties boldly claim space and transform into their truest selves.
